Introduction

Cerebral Palsy Positive (the "**Company**" or "**We**") respects your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy.

This policy describes the types of information We may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website <https://www.cerebralpalsypositive.org/> (the "**Website**") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This policy applies to information We collect:

- On this Website.
- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and this Website.

It does not apply to information collected by:

- Us offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by Company or any third party; or
- Any third party, including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from or through the Website.

Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how We will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use our Website. By accessing or using this Website, you agree to this privacy policy. This policy may change from time to time (see Changes to Our Privacy Policy). Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Website, including information:

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.

Information You Provide to Us

The information We collect on or through our Website may include:

- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us.
- Your responses to surveys that We might ask you to complete for research purposes.

You also may provide information to be published or displayed on public areas of the Website or transmitted to other users of the Website or third parties (collectively, the "**User Contributions**"). Your User Contributions are transmitted to others at your own risk. We cannot and do not guarantee that your User Contributions will not be viewed by unauthorized persons.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies

As you navigate through and interact with our Website, We may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information. The information We collect automatically may include Personal Information, but We may maintain it or associate it with Personal Information We collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve our Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Website according to your individual interests.

The technologies We use for this automatic data collection may include:

We use information that We collect about you or that you provide to us, including any Personal Information:

- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your Personal Information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes.
- If We believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Company, our customers, or others.
